2. While going through his letter we come to conclusion as under:

Date of Retirement: 31.01.2019
Pension drawn under: SAMPANN System
Pension is not drawn for February and March, 2020.
Reason: DLC undeceived.

Your office vides No: CCA/GUJ/PDA/DLC/2019-20/54-123 dated 29.01.2020 had informed the Pensioner to submit the same.

3. We have been informed by the District Secretary that since there was no system available in his town, the Pensioner submitted Physically Verified from the Sr. Post Master, Navsari through Speed Post, twice.
4. Your office was humbly requested that since imposition of lock down, it is not possible for the Pensioner to visit Personally to comply with the requirement, his pension should be drawn till the lock down period is over and then he will present himself to your office.
5. Since your office administration is not prepared to hear genuine prayer, the Pensioner is suffering in these critical hard days of lock down when he is diabetic patient and has to spend the money from the Pension as BSNL has not reimbursed the claims of the pensioners since last three years.

We, therefore, request you to kindly consider the case with humanitarian and practical outlook to assist the pensioner. His liveness can be provisionally verified by talking with him on Phone in presence of Post Master, Navsari, is felt necessary.
