Sub: Issuance of PPO to VRS 2019 BSNL Optees and Orders for Provisional Pension to the Optee up to 31.05.2020.

Hon'ble Sir,

1. Your good self is aware of the fact that in order to save BSNL from its fiscal crisis, Hon'ble P.M. had approved a scheme known as VRS-2019 permitting BSNL Employees to opt for specific date and a software was developed and employees were asked to opt, before specific date and were struck off from 31.01.2020.
2. Your office had issued captioned order to issue PPO to these employees latest by 31st May, 2020 and meanwhile the CCAs were authorized to effect provisional pension to these Optee to avoid financial hardships to them. (Order copy enclosed).
3. And in turn, BSNL Corporate Office had issued Order No: No.48-16/2019-Pen (B) dated 21.02.2020 to process the case from their offices. (Order Copy enclosed).
4. As per information available with us, we have seen the following progress in the matter as on 04.06.2020 in the matter of issuing PPO by CCA Offices.

5. It is seen from the available records, Gujarat Circle, had 6410 VRS-2019 Optees and have generated 6025 PPOs and only 385 remains and if the SSA heads cooperates it will be completed in time.

6. Kerala, Andhra Pradesh and UP East has also performed well.

Since all the CCAs were authorized to pay provisional to these optee up to May, 2020, they will discontinue to pay provisional pension for those whose PPOs are yet to be issued.

We therefore request you to kindly extend the date of effecting provisional pension to the remaining optees up to 30th September,2020.
